Grading Scale:

All courses are assigned GPA weights based on their academic rigor (see chart). The cumulative weighted GPA is calculated by dividing the total GPA points by the total High School credits attempted. The cumulative GPA is calculated at the end of each semester. All courses earning high school credit are included in the cumulative GPA. One-half credit (.5) is granted for each semester course with a passing grade. One full credit (1.0) is granted for each year-long course with a passing grade. Courses are set in 50-minute periods (7-course period possibilities in a day).
